BREED-GROUP-BEST IN SHOW

Competition is offered for dogs & bitches entered and exhibited in the Bred-by-Exhibitor Puppy Class & Bred-by-Exhibitor Adult Class to compete for Best of Breed Bred-By-Exhibitor through Best Bred-By-Exhibitor in Show. Dogs that win Best of Breed or Best of Winners in the regular conformation classes are automatically Best of Breed Bred-By-Exhibitor.

VETERAN • SPECIAL ATTRACTION - SUNDAY

BREED • GROUP • BEST IN SHOW

Competition is offered for dogs & bitches 7 years & older (*divided by sex*) from Best of Breed Veteran through Best Veteran in Show. **Neutered dogs & spayed bitches are eligible to compete.** Veteran Best of Breed will be judged following the regular classes in each breed, Veteran Variety Groups will be held.

NON-REGULAR (ADDITIONAL) CLASSES Involving Single Dog Entries

VETERAN DOG CLASS - A Class for Dogs seven (7) years or older.

VETERAN BITCH CLASS - A Class for Bitches seven (7) years or older.

NON-REGULAR (ADDITIONAL CLASSES) Involving Multiple Dog Entries

As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog Entries is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

STUD DOG CLASS - For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the regular classes, or if a Champion of Record in Best of Breed Competition, but **MUST** be entered in the Stud Dog Class, the Get **MUST** be entered in one of the regular classes. The Stud Dog shall be considered as one entry and requires one entry fee, this being the regular fee plus the additional class fee if the Stud Dog is entered in another class. The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with the Get. The class will be judged on the merits of the Get.

BROOD BITCH CLASS - Same as for the Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

Section 1 - Classifications

- The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for puppies that are over four months of age but under six months on the day of the event.
- Classes are offered for breeds and varieties and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows and the Miscellaneous Class breeds as listed in Chapter 3 Section 23. The Miscellaneous class competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show
- The FSS competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show

Section 2 - Entry and Eligibility

Entry and eligibility requirements include:

- Puppies must have one of the following:
 - An Individual registration number registered with the American Kennel Club (AKC)
 - A Foundation Stock Service (FSS) registration number
 - A foreign born dog may enter if they are registered in the country of origin, as defined in Chapter 11, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Professional handlers, members of their household and current assistants to professional handlers may personally exhibit in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition. Entries must be marked "Exhibition Only" prior to the close of entries.
- Dogs that are owned or co-owned by the forenamed may compete for awards in this competition but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.
- Minors (under 18) with amateur status who reside with professional handlers and current assistants to professional handlers that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may personally exhibit dogs in the Four-to-Six Month Beginner Puppy Competition.

Entries will close WEDNESDAY NOON CDT, April 30, 2025 at the Superintendent's office.

AKC NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLED SERIES

NEBRASKA KENNEL CLUB, INC. - SATURDAY & SUNDAY BRACCO ITALIANO SPECIALTIES - BOTH SHOWS

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.

All dogs that are owner-handled and are not exhibited in the National Owner-Handled Series by professional handlers* meet the requirements for this competition. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the steward’s book & the catalog. **Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner. Professional handlers, household members and current assistants to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any AKC National Owner-Handled Series competition during the entire show. A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend, however current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.**

Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are competing in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes.

The breed will not be represented in the Owner-Handled Group if there is no eligible dog competing in the Best of Breed, or in Best of Winners competition.

**Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers’ organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.*

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards★, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards★, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards★, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards★ in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards★ in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards★ in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.

MASTER CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show and who have won ten (10) Best Junior Handler awards with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and must change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed, all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

★ **A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition counts as one win towards moving to Open.**

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. To obtain junior identification number contact juniors@akc.org. **BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of entry form.**

An FSS Open Show is an informal American Kennel Club sanctioned conformation event at which Championship points are not earned but rather Certificate of Merit (CM) points are awarded to this introductory AKC conformation suffix Title. The FSS Open Shows are events at which dog clubs, judges, stewards, and exhibitors and their dogs gain experience needed for licensed events. All of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows will apply to sanctioned FSS Open Shows, except where otherwise stated in these Regulations which are subject to amendment by the AKC Board of Directors.

- Dogs must be at least 4 months of age on the date of the event
- Dogs less than 4 months of age are ineligible to be on the grounds of licensed or member shows during AKC events.
- Dogs are required to be vaccinated in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol (including rabies vaccination) in order to avoid inadvertent transmission of illness by/to puppies not yet fully immunized.
- Professional handlers or agents are only permitted to exhibit in FSS Open Shows if they are listed as an owner of record of the dog being exhibited. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay.
- No judge or any person residing in the same household with a judge shall exhibit or act as agent or handler at an FSS Open Show at which they are official as judge and dogs owned wholly or in part by such judge or any member of their household shall be ineligible to be entered at the show. Subject to the foregoing, members of a judge's immediate family who no longer reside in the same household may enter or handle a dog at a show if the judge is not officially over any competition, including a group class or best in show, for which the dog is entered or may become eligible.
- No dog is to be judged if it is brought into the ring bandaged, taped, glued or stitched anywhere including ears or tail. These dogs must be excused from judging but, at the judge's discretion, may return to be judged after the tape or bandage is removed.
- The show chair is required to be a member of the show-giving club.
- The show results and event service fee of \$2.00 per entry must be submitted to AKC Event Operations within seven (7) days of the event.
- Dealing with Misconduct will be applicable to any person and dog entered in this computer.
- FSS Open shows must be judged by judges that have an AKC judges number.
- Judges are expected to comply with Rules Applying to Dog Shows and Rules, Policies, and Guidelines for Conformation Dog Show Judges except as follows:
 - Breed standard disqualifications (i.e. color, height, full dentition, etc.) need not be considered in the 4-to-6 Month Puppy classes and male puppies without 2 fully descended testicles need not be disqualified or excused in the 4-to-6 Month Puppy class but the judge's book must describe the condition.
 - In all other classes, male puppies without 2 fully descended testicles need not be disqualified but should be excused and the judge's book must describe the condition and Certificate of Merit points withheld.
 - The speed of judging expectation is reduced to 20 dogs per hour in order to accommodate puppies and inexperienced exhibitors. Judges should interact and encourage exhibitors in order to make their exhibiting a positive experience.
 - Judges may ask exhibitors if they prefer to open their dog's mouth for examination. However judges have the authority to personally open the dog's mouth.
 - No protests against dogs for height, weight or any other breed specific disqualification may be entertained at FSS Open Shows.
 - A dog with a disqualifying condition or behavior shall not be disqualified but shall simply be excused for the day. The judge may only disqualify dogs for attacking in the ring.

CERTIFICATE OF MERIT

All trophies or prizes offered must be awarded for outright award to the owner of the dog.

The Certificate of Merit (CM) Title is an introductory Title to AKC conformation events. Entrants in each breed shall compete for Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed. Winners of the Best of Breed in each of the individual breeds will be awarded points toward the CM Title based on the number of dogs competing in their breed. Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed in each of the individual breeds will be awarded points towards the Certificate of Merit (CM) title based on the total number of dogs competing in their sex. Group winners will be eligible for the points based on the total number of dogs that competed in the Group. Best in Show will be eligible for the points based on the total number of dogs that competed in the show.

Hotel/Motel Information

The Bracco 2025 National Specialty has a block of rooms reserved at the Best Western Plus Lincoln Inn and Suites in Lincoln, NE. In addition, the Nebraska Kennel Club has a list of motel/hotel rooms available within the premium. Prices will vary as will pet fees.

The Best Western Plus is located in an area of car dealerships and one other hotel. It has numerous poop bag dispensers with garbage cans. There are 2 hay fields across. The back parking lot, and traffic compared to some other hotels is greatly reduced. The room rate is \$175.00 per night plus a flat \$10 fee for up to three dogs. There is a free breakfast buffet in the lobby area which varies every day. Wi-Fi and parking, even buses are free.

Rules are simple, dogs must be housebroken, quiet, and picked up after. Dogs cannot be left alone in the rooms. The elevators will easily accommodate luggage and crates. On the site visit, there were numerous dogs in and out of the hotel without issue and the staff was very dog friendly.

Booking must be completed by April 15, 2025. They require a minimum of 2 night stay Friday and Saturday, but there is availability for Wednesday, Thursday and Sunday nights. Check in is 3:00 pm, check out is noon. Baggage storage is available and secure.

There will likely be a shortage of rooms in Lincoln that weekend, as it is the University's graduation, please take this into consideration when planning RV PARKING.

RV parking is available at the Sandhills Global Event Center - 2400 spots; and there are approximately 5 spots at the Oak Creek Sporting Club.

The Sandhills Global Event Center will be the "Host" site. The Specialty has a large room that will be used for seminars, meals, auction, and a place to congregate during the event. Because food is served, dogs are not allowed in this room at any time. This is Nebraska state law. The committee has arranged a very large private room located right next to the Banquet room for crates, gear etc. The ring for the specialties, Special Attraction, Top 20 recognition and honoring the Veterans is literally just outside the Banquet room door. There are new bathroom facilities, wash areas for dogs and showers available. There will be a ringside photo area complete with a backdrop suitable for professional photos. The event crew will need at times to convert the room from a seminar space to the Banquet space.

Beagles (not exceeding 13 in. over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.). Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard), Collies (rough, smooth).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition; Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC (For complete rules refer to Chapter 11, Section 3).
5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience and Rally trials should mark Breed as AKC Canine Partners Listed Dog "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
